Vision Screening

Prevent Blindness will be here to provide a special photo screening program for our students.

This test takes less than one minute. The screener takes a photo of the child's eye and they are then able to screen for eye disorders found in early childhood.

Prevent Blindness will then send a report with their results about a month later.



We have had children who this has helped diagnose early the need for alasses.

If you have any questions please do not hesitate to ask. More information will be coming home regarding this program.
